POLICIES FOR LEASING AN ANIMAL IN THE GOAT PROGRAM

1. Leases will be permitted for breeding stock (i.e. Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Pygmy Goat, etc...) Market goats, harness goats and pack goats must be owned by the exhibitor.
2. Exhibitor leasing that animal must be enrolled in the goat project by the entry deadline.
3. Animal to be leased must be "obtained" by May 1, 2005 and a completed lease agreement must be submitted to the 4-H Office by June 15, 2005.
4. Exhibitor needs to keep all records on that animal required for that project.
5. If animal does not reside on exhibitor property, then exhibitor must spend a reasonable amount of time caring for and working with that animal.
6. For Dairy animals, a copy of the owner's ADGA registration papers must accompany the lease form.
7. Leased animals may include kids born out of a leased doe, providing project records are kept on the kids.
8. Should the animal during the leased period become unable to be shown due to death or serious medical condition, it may be replaced with another animal. Circumstances to be reviewed by the goat committee for approval.
9. Leased Dairy Goats cannot be exhibited at State Fair (See State Fair animal ownership requirements).
