4-H Agricultural Grant Program

Stanley A. Weeks of Jamestown has long been interested in youth and in particular, encouragement of youth activities in the field of agriculture. He has established a \$10,000.00 endowment fund with the Chautauqua Region Community Foundation for the specific purpose of providing monetary awards to young people involved in the Chautauqua County 4-H Program. The awards will be given to those 4-H members who have made a significant accomplishment in Horticulture, Conservation, Animal Science, or Agricultural Engineering.

Mr. Weeks has named the 4-H Program Committee as the award Selection Committee in keeping with the Chautauqua County 4-H Program. Members will submit an application to the 4-H Program Committee via the 4-H Office and award recipients will be named at the annual 4-H Achievement Night.

AWARDS CRITERIA

The following criteria for the Stanley A. Weeks Fund was established by the 4-H Program Committee based on recommendations by Stanley Weeks at their May 18, 1987 4-H Program Committee meeting.

1. Maximum of three and a minimum of two award winners will be chosen annually. Monetary awards will be based on interest earned annually and divided equally among recipients.
2. Award recipients must show evidence that they will follow a career in Horticulture, Conservation, Animal Science, or Agricultural Engineering.
3. Award recipients may receive a monetary grant only once from this fund.
4. Award recipients must have been an enrolled member for at least three years.
5. Award recipients must show significant accomplishments in the area they apply for during the past 4-H year.
6. As of the September application deadline, applicant: must be a senior in high school or a member of the previous June graduating class.
