Deadline – April 1, 2024

Criteria: Applicants must have completed a minimum of three years in the Chautauqua County 4-H Beef Program with an additional two years of 4-H and/or FFA activities. Preference will be given to students who have completed consecutive years in the Beef Program and/or students pursuing studies in a livestock or agricultural related field. *Applicants must be high school graduates of the Class of 2023 or Class of 2024.*

A complete application will include the following:

1. This form
2. Copy of your most recent high school transcript (official or unofficial)
3. Copies that document your participation in the 4-H Beef Program (certificates, projects, awards, etc.)
4. A one-page, typed essay that describes the following:
 - a. Your participation in the 4-H Beef Program
 - b. How the 4-H Beef Program has influenced your life
 - c. Your desire to pursue higher education in your selected field of study
