Position Description: 4-H Youth must be at least 10 years or older to apply. 4-H Youth will complete the application for the opportunity to be a 4-H Youth Tour Guide on Monday, July 15th, 2025, at the Chautauqua County Fair. 4-H Office Staff, with input from animal project committee members, will select the 4-H Youth Tour Guides and notify them of their barn placement by no later than July 3rd, 2025. 4-H Youth Tour Guides will guide non-4-H students through the barn they are selected for. 4-H Youth Tour Guides must describe their selected 4-H Animal Project, their experience in 4-H, and answer questions from the students as appropriate. 4-H Youth Tour Guides will be given a stipend of \$50 per barn that they are selected for. Applications can be submitted by emailing them to jla298@cornell.edu, by mailing them to the 4-H Office at 525 Falconer St. PO Box 20, Jamestown, NY, or by delivering them to our office in the JCC Carnahan Center.
